About the Band

Celebrating its 130th Anniversary in 2025, The Band of the Hampshire and Isle of Wight Constabulary is based at the Police Training Headquarters at Netley, Southampton. Its members are made up of serving and retired police officers and staff and their families, alongside civilian volunteers where instrumentation is required. The band is a military style concert band consisting of woodwind, brass, and percussion sections, and its wide repertoire ranges from marches and overtures through classical pieces to selections and extracts from popular shows, films and musicals. The band performs in concerts all across the South of England, helping to raise many thousands of pounds for charities each year.

Director of Music Greg Walker BA(Hons)

Born into a musical family, Greg has been surrounded by music from an early age, originally learning clarinet and piano from the age of 7, and later saxophone. At the age of 15 Greg took up lessons on drum kit, passing his Grade 8 within 6 months of lessons, and has since studied with John Roberts, Dan Priest, Ted

Carrasco, and Craig Blundell. His love of everything music led to him furthering his studies at the University of Southampton where he majored and gained first class honours in percussion performance and orchestral conducting.



In his day job, Greg is the Progression and Musical Development Lead for Hampshire Music Hub, where he oversees music provision in around 600 Hampshire schools. He is also Head of Percussion and Rock & Pop, and works closely with the Hampshire County Youth Wind Ensemble and Hampshire Percussion Ensemble. His love and dedication to music education has led to him receiving teaching endorsements with some of the world's biggest

percussion companies, including Vic Firth, Roland UK, and D'addario.

Alongside his post of Director of Music with the Band of the Hampshire and Isle of Wight Constabulary, he conducts and rehearses other local professional and amateur bands and ensembles, also holding the post of Principal Director of Music with the 14th Eastleigh Scout and Guide Band ('The Spitfires').

In his spare time, Greg has been heavily involved in Scouting for the past 30 years, currently holding the post of Group Lead Volunteer with a scout group in Eastleigh. For his sins, Greg is a keen Southampton FC supporter and can be found playing the bass drum for the club's band 'Saints Brass' on match days.
